Sermon: Part 2: Pride and Money **Date:** Sunday, January 19th, 2025

"I will ascend to the Heavens; I will raise my throne above the stars of God; I will sit enthroned on the mount of assembly, on the utmost heights of Mount Zaphon. I will ascend above the tops of the clouds; I will make myself like the Most High." (Isaiah 14:13-14)

"Did God really say, 'You must not eat from any tree in the garden'?" ... "For God knows that when you eat from it your eyes will be opened, and you will be like God, knowing good and evil." (Genesis 3:1, 5)

The root to all sin is _______ because our pride causes us to exalt ourselves above God.

Satan rose up against Israel and incited David to take a census of Israel. So David said to Joab and the commanders of the troops, "Go and count the Israelites from Beersheba to Dan. Then report back to me so that I may know how many there are." But Joab replied, "May the Lord multiply His troops a hundred times over. My lord the king, are they not all my lord's subjects? Why does my lord want to do this? Why should he bring guilt on Israel?" (1 Chronicles 21:1-3)

Pride _____ us and causes us to do whatever we are set on doing even if it is going to lead to pain and destruction for us and others.

The king's word, however, overruled Joab; so Joab left and went throughout Israel and then came back to Jerusalem. Joab reported the number of the fighting men to David: In all Israel there were one million one hundred thousand men who could handle a sword, including four hundred and seventy thousand in Judah. (1 Chronicles 21:4-5)

The Earth is the Lord's, and everything in it, the world, and all who live in it... (Psalm 24:1)

A steward: Someone who an owner entrusts with the management of their possessions

If we think that we own, then we will be prideful. If we know that God is the One who actually owns and what we have is a gift to be managed on His behalf, well that brings humility and gratitude.

This command [for the census] was also evil in the sight of God; so He punished Israel. "I have sinned greatly by doing this. Now, I beg You, take away the guilt of Your servant. I have done a very foolish thing." (1 Chronicles 21:7-8)
