"Suppose one of you has a hundred sheep and loses one of them. Doesn't He leave the ninety-nine in the open country and go after the lost sheep until He finds it? And when He finds it, He joyfully puts it on His shoulders and goes home. Then He calls His friends and neighbors together and says, 'Rejoice with Me; I have found My lost sheep.' I tell you that in the same way there will be more rejoicing in Heaven over one sinner who repents than over ninety-nine righteous persons who do not need to repent." (Luke 15:4-7)

## **Different Responses People Have When The Topic Of Jesus Comes Up**

1. People will be towards Jesus
: comes from the Greek words euaggelion meaning good news or Gospel and euaggelizo meaning to declare, share, and preach this Good News of salvation
We shouldn't expect everyone to evangelize in the same way, but rather encourage each believer to use their gifts to contribute to the Church's overall witness.
If we can understand that God has uniquely created us and has given us the responsibility to fulfill a mission so that others can find new life in Jesus, we can become a more effective and authentic witness for Jesus to the world that is so desperately searching for hope and answers.
"If the world hates you, keep in mind that it hated Me first. If you belonged to the world, it would love you as its own. As is, you do not belong to the world, but I have chosen you out of the world. That is why the world hates you If they persecuted Me, they will persecute you also They will treat you this way because of My Name, for they do not know the One who sent Me. 'They hated Me without reason.' (John 15:18-21,25)

"I am sending you out like sheep among wolves. Therefore be as shrewd as snakes and as innocent as doves." (Matthew 10:16)
