The _____ is known as the Good News concerning Jesus and the way of salvation.



1. God loves us so much that He created us to have a relationship with Him so we could do life with Him

2. Humans decided to go their own way and chose to do life without God, causing sin to enter into this world and our lives

For all have sinned and fall short of the glory of God... (Romans 3:23)

3. God loves us so much that He came as a human, named Jesus, and died on a cross in order to forgive us for our sins, thus creating an avenue for our relationship with God to be made right again

"The wages of sin is death." (Romans 6:23)

An infinite God can die for infinite sins.

But God demonstrates His own love for us in this: While we were still sinners, Christ died for us. (Romans 5:8)

4. All of us, individually, have a choice to make to respond to what God has done by inviting Jesus to be our Savior for the forgiveness of sins as we allow Him to be Lord of our lives

For it is by grace you have been saved, through faith - and this is not from yourselves, it is the gift of God - not by works, so that no one can boast. (Ephesians 2:8-9)

Jesus' _____ brought redemption and restoration to not only us, but even this world. That is why we have hope, why we can experience transformation, and why the Gospel message is Good News.

Bottom Line: One of the greatest joys about following Jesus is helping others to follow Jesus.
