Jesus emphasized that our ______ for one another would serve as a testament to the world.

When He saw the crowds, He had compassion on them, because they were harassed and helpless, like sheep without a Shepherd. (Matthew 9:36)

For many, God is not even on their radar as a possible solution. So what's missing? Well, it is an invitation by us for them to follow Jesus.

Some Truths of the Gospel That Can Motivate and Compel Us To Share Our Faith With Others:

1. The glory and ______ of Jesus

The god of this age has blinded the minds of unbelievers, so that they cannot see the Light of the Gospel that displays the glory of Christ, Who is the image of God. (2 Corinthians 4:4)

For since the creation of the world God's invisible qualities - His eternal power and divine nature - have been clearly seen, being understood from what has been made, so that people are without excuse. For although they knew God, they neither glorified Him as God nor gave thanks to Him, but their thinking became futile and their foolish hearts were darkened. (Romans 1:20-21)

This was the motivation for believers for evangelism: that God's glory will reign.



It was for the sake of the Name that they went out... (3 John 1:7)

But He was pierced for our transgressions, He was crushed for our iniquities; the punishment that brought us peace was on Him, and by His wounds we are healed. (Isaiah 53:5)
