Sermon: Part 3: God In The Boat **Date:** Sunday, July 20th, 2025

"Fear defeats more people than any other one thing in the world." (Ralph Waldo Emerson)

Miracles: Significant events that either pause or reverse the typical operation of nature and that cannot be explained by natural laws. They are times where God intervenes in the natural order of things and does something seemingly unexpected, impossible, and yet extraordinary

Jesus demonstrated numerous miracles, not so that people would be drawn to the miracles, but so that they would be drawn to the God behind the miracles.

Scripture referenced in sermon message: John 16:33, Matthew 10:28

Because God is in control over all things, Jesus is saying to His disciples, and even to us: that if anyone is going to follow Him, that they should actually be more afraid of Him, meaning have a reverent _____ of Him and His authority, rather than having a fear of everything else that is under Him.

What situations are you facing that are causing fear in your life today?

That day when evening came, He [Jesus] said to His disciples, "Let us go over to the other side." Leaving the crowd behind, they took Him along, just as He was, in the boat. There were also other boats with Him. A furious squall came up, and the waves broke over the boat, so that it was nearly swamped. Jesus was in the stern, sleeping on a cushion. The disciples woke Him [Jesus] and said to Him, "Teacher, don't You care if we drown?" Jesus got up, rebuked the wind and said to the waves, "Quiet! Be still!" Then the wind died down and it was completely calm. (Mark 4:35-39)
